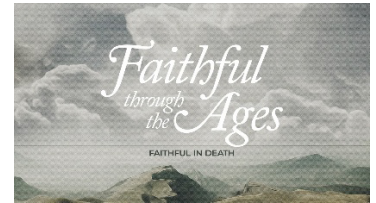


# *Faithful through the Ages*

Next Steps: Home-Group Study and/or Personal Discipleship Guide

Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!

**Start with Prayer:** Ask Jesus to guide our time together. Review prayer requests.

**Anchor Question:** What does true faithfulness look like in everyday life, and how does Jesus show us the way?

**Read the text** (or portions) from 2 different versions – **Luke 22:39-23:49**

**Pauses for Reflection and Discussion –**

1. “Some moments are too significant to rush past.”
  - *What are some habits, or rhythms that have helped you to slow down enough to truly see Jesus, his words, attitudes, and actions, instead of just remembering or rehearsing the events leading up to the cross.*
2. “Nevertheless, not My will, but Yours be done.”
  - *Where is God inviting you to trust His will, even when the path ahead is feeling difficult or costly?*
3. “In the events leading to the cross, everywhere we look, human faithfulness is collapsing, while Jesus remains perfectly faithful.”
  - *How does the unchanging faithfulness of Jesus give hope when we become painfully aware of our own failures?*
4. “Even while the world rejected Him, Jesus remained exactly who He had always been.”
  - *How might our relationships change if our character remained steady, even as our circumstances grew more difficult?*
5. “Father, forgive them...”
  - *What does Jesus’ prayer from the cross teach us about the depths of God’s mercy, and where might His mercy need to reshape our own hearts?*
6. “The One who remained faithful unto death remains faithful still.”
  - *What does it mean for us today to entrust ourselves to our faithful Savior?*
